Important Development of Phenoxyethanol in France

Below is a note prepared by Federation of Beauty Companies (FEBA) on a summary of the recent developments on the situation on phenoxyethanol in France. In August 2012, the ANSM report was transmitted to the European Commission for a Community evaluation. The SCCS performed this evaluation, with a final opinion on phenoxyethanol adopted in October 2016. In Mid-October 2016, FEBEA asked the ANSM to refer to the SCCS opinion on phenoxyethanol and to remove its recommendation from its Website, as it is contrary to the SCCS opinion. The recommendation on the website was not to use phenoxyethanol in cosmetic products designed for application on the nappy area of children under 3 years of age and to limit the concentration at 0.4% for all other products intended for children under 3 years of age. Chemicals Management Plan Science Committee

Science Approach Document for the Ecological Risk Classification of Inorganic Substances

An <u>update</u> to the Science Approach Document for the Ecological Risk Classification of Inorganic Substances was published. A science approach document (SciAD) provides a description of a

scientific approach to evaluate environmental or human health risk of substances. SciADs also include the results of the application of the scientific approach to substances that were identified as priorities for assessment because they met the categorization criteria under section 73 of CEPA. In January 2020, the updated Science Approach Document for the Ecological Risk Classification of Inorganic Substances was released. The approach was revised based on comments received during the 60-day public comment period on the May 2018 version.

MHSW Wind Up Plan Approval Pending

The Resource Productivity and Recovery Authority (RPRA) is expected to approve Stewardship Ontario's MHSW Wind Up Plan by December 31, 2019. An appendix to the Wind Up Plan and the 2020 Rules for MHSW Stewards will be addressed in the approval. Stewardship Ontario will notify stakeholders as soon as the plan and Rules have been approved and are posted on its website. Development of the Blue Box Wind Up Plan

Initiated by a <u>direction letter</u> from the Minister of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP), Stewardship Ontario is required to submit a Blue Box Program Wind Up Plan to the Resource Productivity and Recovery Authority (RPRA) by June 30, 2020.
